ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

BSNL enlisted contractors in the Electrical category of respective class as per their tendering limits.

Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, who have scanned and uploaded the following documents (and whose uploaded documents are found to be in order), otherwise the bid will not be opened and shall lead to disqualification.

Not uploading the above documents, (even if the documents are submitted physically) shall lead to disqualification.

2. The Physical Tender Fee, EMD, the original authorisation letter by the manufacturer (wherever applicable), (the scanned copies of which are uploaded) shall be deposited in the tender box available in the office of tender opening authority, by the bidder within in 5 days from the tender opening date, failing which the tender will not be considered for further processing.

Item rate tenders on single bid system are invited on behalf of CMD, BSNL for the work "Shifting of Kushkumar Admin building to KKNagar TE and Electrification work at 4th floor of KK Nagar TE." from the eligible bidders as per NIT notification. The enlistment of the bidders should be valid on the opening date of tender. In case the date of opening of tender is extended, the enlistment of bidder should be valid on the original date of opening of tender.

- 1. Intending bidder is eligible to submit the bid provided that he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority as per the eligibility conditions mentioned in the NIT notification page.
- 2. The work is estimated to cost Rs.4,06,837/-(excluding GST)
- 3. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidder on prescribed form as amended up to the date of opening of tender. Bidder shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
- 4. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **One Month** from the 10th day after the date of written order to commence the work.
- 5. The site for the work is available / or the site for the works shall be made available in parts. The successful bidder shall execute the work in coordination with other agencies working in the campus.
- 6. The bid documents consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website https://etenders.gov.in at free of cost. The BSNL EW-8 document can be seen from the web site www.chennai.bsnl.co.in at free of cost.
- 7. After submission of the bid, the bidder can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of tender as notified. While submitting the revised bid, bidder can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not reenter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of tender as notified.
- 8. The Tender Fee in the form of Demand Draft issued by the Nationalized / Scheduled bank authorized by the Reserve Bank of India, drawn in favour of BSNL, CHENNAI TELPHONES payable at CHENNAI shall be scanned & uploaded in the e-tendering website within the period of tender submission. The validity of the tender cost in the form of DD shall be 60 days from the date of opening.
- 9. The Earnest money deposit (EMD) in the form of Demand Draft / FDR / BG (BG is only for Air Conditioning, Diesel Engine Alternator, Lifts, and Sub Station works wherever the amount of EMD is more than Rs.20,000)/ CDR of a nationalized / scheduled bank authorized by the Reserve Bank of India, drawn in favour of BSNL, CHENNAI TELPHONES payable at CHENNAI shall be scanned & uploaded in the e-tendering website within the period of tender submission. The validity of the EMD in the form of DD shall be 60 days from the date of opening. If the EMD is in the form of CDR/FDR/BG, the validity shall be 180 days from the

- date of opening. In case of L1 bidder, the validity of CDR/FDR/BG is to be extended up to the observation period as that of the Performance guarantee / Security deposit.
- 10. The Physical **TENDER COST** and **EMD** of which the scanned copy is uploaded shall be deposited by all the bidders before 3:00 PM on the tender opening date, failing which the tender shall not be opened.
- 11. All the documents as specified in the tender document shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission.
- 12. Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, who have deposited e-Tender Processing Fee with M/s ITI Limited and Earnest Money Deposit and other documents fulfilling eligibility criteria, scanned and uploaded are found in order.
- 13. The last date for online submission of bid is 18-11-2023 up to 3:00 PM and the bid submitted shall be opened at 03:30 on PM 18-11-2023. If a holiday is declared on the tender opening day, the tender will be opened on the next working day.
- 14. The e-Tender processing fee is non-refundable.
- 15. Performance Guarantee: The bidder is required to furnish Performance guarantee for an amount equal to 5% of the contract value in the form of bank guarantee/CDR/FDR/DD (of a nationalized/ Scheduled Bank in a standard format) within two weeks from the date of issue of acceptance letter. This period can be further extended by the Engineer-incharge up to a maximum period of two weeks on written request of Bidder. The validity period of the performance security in the form of performance bank guarantee shall be: Three Months from the date of actual completion of work, for AMC works; and One year from the date of actual completion of work for all other works. In case the bidder fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the stipulated period, including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the bidder shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the bidder and the bidder will not be allowed to participate in the re tendering for the same work.
- 16. Security Deposit: In addition to Performance guarantee stated above, a sum @ 10% of the gross amount of the bill shall be deducted from each running bill of the contractor till the sum be deducted with the sum already deposited as earnest money, will amount to security deposit of 5% of the contract value of the work. The security deposit shall be released after an observation period as follows: Three Months from the date of actual completion of work, for AMC works; and One year from the date of actual completion of work for all other works.
- 17. In case any discrepancy is noticed in the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of the bid online, then the bid submitted shall become invalid and the BSNL shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further, the bidder shall not be allowed to participate in the retendering process of the work.
- 18. Intending bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders, the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on

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any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidder shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a tender by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the BSNL and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

- 19. The competent authority on behalf of the CMD does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without the assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidder shall be summarily rejected. The competent authority on behalf of CMD reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the bidder shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
- 20. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the bidders who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
- 21. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidder on prescribed form. Bidder shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form, which will form part of the agreement.
- 22. The bidder should give a certificate as per the following that none of his/her relative is employed in BSNL units as per **Form 'D'**. In case of proprietorship firm, certificate will be given by the proprietor and for partnership firm certificate will be given by all the Directors of the company.
 - a. Near relatives of all BSNL employees either directly recruited or on deputation are prohibited from participation in tenders and execution of works in the different units of BSNL. The near relatives for this purpose are defined as:
 - i. Members of a Hindu Undivided family.
 - ii. They are husband and wife.
 - iii. The one is related to the other in the manner as father, mother, son(s) & son's wife(daughter-in-law), Daughter(s) & daughter's husband(son-in-law), brother(s) & brother's wife, sister(s) & sister's husband(brother -in-law).
 - b. The company or firm or any other person is not permitted to tender for works in BSNL unit in which his near relative(s) is(are) posted. The unit is defined as SSA/Circle/Chief Engineer/Chief Archt./Corporate office for non-executive employees and all SSA in a circle including circle office/Chief Eng./Chief Archt./Corporate office for executive employees (including those called as Gazetted officers at present). The bidder should give a certificate that none of his/her such near relative is working in the units as defined above where he is going to apply for tender/work, for proprietorship, partnership firms and limited company certificate shall be given by the authorized signatory of the firm. Any breach of these conditions by the company or firm or any other person, the tender/work will be cancelled and earnest money/performance guarantee will be forfeited at any stage whenever it is so noticed. BSNL will not pay any damages to the company or firm or the concerned person. The company or firm or the person will also be debarred for further participation in the concerned unit.

- c. No employee in BSNL/ Govt. of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of two years of his retirement from service without the prior permission. The contract is liable to be cancelled if either the bidder or any of his employees is found at any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission as aforesaid before submission of tender and engagement in the bidders service.
- 23. The tender for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of opening of tenders. If any bidder withdraws his tender before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the BSNL, then the BSNL shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the tenderer shall not be allowed to participate in the retendering process of the work.
- 24. The agency has to comply with the provisions of EPF and miscellaneous provisions Act-1952 and employees provident fund scheme-1952 as amended up to date in respect of labours/employees engaged by them for this work. Any consequence arising due to non-complying of provisions as specified above shall be the sole responsibility of the firm only. The agency shall give an undertaking to this effect as per **Form 'B'**.
- 25. **Extension of Validity of tender:** In case, where the letter of award of work cannot be placed within the validity period of the tender, the BSNL can request the bidder to extend the validity of their respective tenders and the Earnest Money deposit by a reasonable period. In such cases, extension of validity of Earnest Money deposit by 30 days beyond the extended validity date of tender should also be asked for. While BSNL can make the request for extension, the tenderer is free to either extend the validity or refuse the request to extend the validity.
- 26. Rates quoted by the contractor shall be firm and shall be valid for the currency of contract. No cost escalation shall be permitted during the currency of contract.
- 27. This notice inviting tender shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder, on acceptance of his tender by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:
 - a. The Notice Inviting Tender, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming part of the tender as uploaded at the time of invitation of tender, subsequent amendments issued and the rates quoted online at the time of submission of bid and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.
 - b. Standard BSNL EW-8 form.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS

- 1. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of BSNL-EW 6 carefully. He should only submit his bid, if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
- 2. Information and instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
- 3. Applicants are advised to keep visiting the above mentioned website from time to time (till the deadline for bid submission) for any updates in respect of the tender documents, if any. Failure to do so shall not absolve the applicant of his liabilities to submit the applications complete in all respect including updates thereof, if any. An incomplete application may be liable for rejection.
- 4. Those bidders not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered themselves beforehand. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
- 5. On opening date, the bidder can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
- 6. Bidder can upload eligibility documents in the form of JPG format or / and PDF format. Documents uploaded in any other format, which could not be opened may result in non opening of the bids.
- 7. Bidder must ensure to quote rate of each item. The column meant for quoting rate in figures appears in yellow colour. In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO)
- 8. Even though any bidder may satisfy the above requirements, he would be liable to disqualification if he has:
 - a. Made misleading or false representation or deliberately suppressed the information in the forms, statements and enclosures required in the eligibility criteria document.
 - b. Record of poor performance such as abandoning work, not properly completing the contract, or financial failures / weaknesses etc.
- 9. If any information furnished by the bidder is found incorrect at a later stage, he shall be liable to be debarred from tendering/taking up of works in BSNL. The BSNL reserves the right to verify the particulars furnished by the applicant independently.
- 10. GST and any other tax applicable in respect of this contract as applicable shall be borne by the bidder himself. The bidder shall quote his rates considering all such taxes. The TDS as per the Govt. regulations will be recovered from the contractor.

11. Tender Evaluation:

- (a) The evaluation and comparison of responsive bids shall be done on the basis of **Net cost to BSNL** on the prices offered inclusive of packing, forwarding, freight and insurance charges etc., but excluding GST. The bid with lowest net cost as elaborated above will be the L1 bidder.
- (b) Vendors should furnish the correct GST Rate in the price schedule. If the Input Tax Credit is found to be not admissible at any stage subsequently owing to wrong furnishing of GST Rate, then the vendors will be liable to refund such non-admissible amount, if already paid, along with penalty if charged by the concerned authority.
- 12. However, pursuant to the constitution (Forty-sixth amendment) act, 1982, if any further tax or levy is imposed by statute, after the last date of receipt of tenders, and the contractors there upon necessarily and properly pays such taxes/ levies, the contractor shall be reimbursed the

amount so paid, provided such payment, if any, is not in the opinion of Superintending engineer (whose decision shall be final and binding) be attributable to delay in execution of work within the control of contractor.

13. The Contractor shall, within a period of 30 days of imposition of any further tax or levy in pursuant to the constitution of (Forty sixth amendment) act 1982 give a written notice thereof to the Engineer-in-charge that the same is given pursuant to this condition, together with all necessary information relating thereto.

14. Bye laws Indemnity against liabilities:

- a. The bidder shall comply with all by laws and regulations of the local and statutory authorities having jurisdiction over the works and shall be responsible for payment of all fees and other charges and giving and receiving all necessary notices and keep the Engineer-in-charge informed about the notices issued and received.
- b. The bidder shall indemnify the department against all claims in respect of patent rights design, trademark or name of other protected rights in respect of any plant, machine, work or materials used for or in connection with the works or temporary works and from and against all claims demands, proceedings, costs, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect of or in relation thereto.
- c. The bidder shall defend all actions arising from such claims and shall himself pay all royalties, License fees, damages, costs and charges of all and every sort that may be legally incurred in respect hereof shall be borne by the bidder.
- d. All liabilities / penal recoveries on matters arising out of tax/levies such as incorrect deductions discrepancies in the filing of returns, revised assessments by the concerned authorities etc., shall be borne by the bidder.

15. Termination of contract on death of contractor:

Without prejudice of any of the rights or remedies under this contract, if the contractor dies, the Engineer in charge on behalf of the BSNL shall have the option of terminating the contract without compensation to the contractor.

- 16. Indulging of contractor in criminal /antisocial activities and cases under investigation/charge sheeted by CBI or any other government agencies etc. :
 - If the CBI/Independent External Monitor (IEM) /Income tax/ Sales Tax /GST/Central Excise/Custom Departments recommend such a course Action will be taken as per the directions of CBI or concerned department.
- 17. As a general notion, the terms and conditions/instructions contained in various pages of this document are addressed assuming the bidder as 'Male'. However, the same shall remain and assumed to be addressed in case of 'Female' bidder also, except for the gender centric words, which shall be 'female' centric at appropriate places.
 - 18. **Factory Visit:** The contractor has to arrange for a factory visit by the DISCOM official accompanied by a BSNL representative. No extra charges for the same shall be paid.

Please note that the offers, which do not comply the following, will not be considered and will be totally rejected. These instructions supersede the BSNL/EW 8 clauses in case of any Disparity.

1 (i) INCREASE / DECREASE OF TENDERED QUANTITY

- a) BSNL will have the right to increase or decrease up to 25% of the Contract value depending upon the requirement of goods and services specified in the schedule of items without any change in the unit price or other terms and conditions at the time of award of contract.
- In exceptional situation where the requirement is of an emergent nature and it is necessary to ensure continued supplies from the existing vendors, the purchaser reserves the right to place repeat orders up to 50% of the quantity of goods and services contained in the running tender/contract within a period of 12 months from date of award of work at the same rate or a rate negotiated (downwardly) with the existing vendors considering the reasonability of rates based on prevailing market conditions and the impact of reduction in duties and taxes etc.

1 (ii) **CURTAILMENT OF QUANTITY**:-

BSNL reserves the right to enforce curtailment in the assigned quantum of work for any contractor on the grounds of defaults/delay in regard to execution of the individual work assigned.

2) <u>COMPLETION OF WORK</u>:-

At the time of issuing NIT for a particular work, the time allowed for completion of work consistent with magnitude and urgency of work is specified. The time allowed for carrying out the work as entered in the contract is reckoned from the tenth day after the date on which the orders to commence the work are given to the Contractor. To ensure good progress of the work during the execution, the contractor is bound in all cases in which the time allowed for any work exceeds one month (except special jobs) to complete $1/8^{th}$ of the whole of the work before $1/8^{th}$ of the time allowed under the contract has elapsed, $3/8^{th}$ of the work before half of the time has elapsed and $3/4^{th}$ of the work before $3/4^{th}$ of such time has elapsed. However, for special jobs, if a time schedule has been submitted by the Contractor and the same has been accepted by the Engineer-in-charge, the contractor shall comply with such time schedule. For Substation, the work is deemed to have been completed after clearance by Electrical Inspector.

3) **EXTENSION OF TIME**:-

If the contractor shall desire an extension of time for completion of work on the grounds of his having been unavoidably hindered in its execution or on any other grounds, he shall apply in writing to the

Engineer in charge within 30 days of the hindrance on the account on which he desires such extension as aforesaid, and the Engineer in charge shall if in his opinion reasonable grounds to be shown therefore, authorize such provisional extension of time, if any as in his opinion be necessary are proper.

4) **COMPENSATION FOR DELAY:**

If the contractor fails to maintain the required progress or complete the work and clear the site on or before the contract or extended date of completion, he has to pay the compensation for delay which is limited to 0.5% per week of the tendered value for the first 10 weeks and 0.7% per week for next 10 weeks and thereafter subject to a maximum of 12% of the tendered value for the location where the work is delayed and the firm is found responsible for the same. The clause 2 of BSNL - 8 forms stands modified accordingly. Flow chart of the Procurement process/ contract shall be supplied by the contractor and approved by Executive Engineer concerned.

5) TERMS OF PAYMENT:

- 1. 90% of pro-rata of the approved price breakup of contract value on receipt of equipment at site and after satisfactory physical inspection.
- 2. 10% of pro-rata of the approved price breakup of contract value after successful installation and commissioning of the equipment.

6) EPF PROVISIONS:-

The agency has to comply with the provisions of EPF and miscellaneous provisions Act-1952 and employees provident fund scheme-1952 as amended up to date in respect of labours /employees engaged by them for this work. Any consequence arising due to non- complying of provisions as specified above shall be the sole responsibility of the firm only.

Agency has to observe all the labour rules & regulation in force. Agency shall be fully responsible for any violation observed at any time.

7) PROGRAMME FOR EXECUTION

8) STORES AND SAFETY

9) CO-ORDINATION AT SITE

At the site of work more than one agency may be working. Full cooperation shall be extended to other agencies during the progress of work. Further work shall be carried out in such a way so that it may not cause abnormal noise and hindrance to the officers of the BSNL engaged in erection as well as to normal routine work.

10) <u>COMPLETION DRAWINGS</u>

The firm shall supply three sets of drawings/documents after completion of the work but before the proposed date of completion of work.

11) CHANGES IN SPECIFICATIONS

Prior approval is necessary before undertaking any alteration/modification in the specifications of the equipment.

The entire system shall conform to relevant BIS including safety standards as amended up to date. Where IS standards are not available the British standard(s) shall be followed. In case of conflict, the requirements of these specifications shall be given over-riding priority. The electrical and earthing work shall be carried out as per CPWD specifications for electrical works (internal) and electrical works (external) as amended up to date. A list of relevant standards, approved makes of equipment is furnished and forms part of the tender document.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR EI & FANS

The work shall be done as per current CPWD Specification. For Electrical works amended from time to time & Indian Electricity Rules as attended up to date.

The work shall be supervised by qualified technical staff of the Contractor.

The layout of the work will be given by the Engineer in charge or his duly authorized representative at the site of work.

The following wiring shall be done in separate conduits:-

- A) Power plug wiring.
- B) Light & Fan point wiring.
- C) Emergency Light point wiring (AC Supply/DC Supply)
- D) Telephone wiring.
- E) Clock wiring.
- F) AC Unit wiring.

The number of power plug points, and emergency light points fed from DC supply shall not exceed two per circuit in any of the cases.

The earthing sets shall be provided in presence of engineer in charge or his authorized representative.

Sample of all the materials, fittings, accessories, IC switch gears etc., shall be got approved from the Engineer in-charge before using the same on work. The rejected materials shall be removed immediately from the site of work.

The Contractor will be have to carry out the following tests at his cost and intimate test results before final bills are paid. Nothing extra will be paid to him on this account.

- a) Earth Test
- b) Polarity test
- c) Insulation test
- d) Earth continuity test of the surface/recessed conduits.

Any damage done to the building, by the Contractor during the execution of work shall have to be made god at his cost and risk. If he does not do it himself within a reasonable time determined by the Engineer In-charge the same will be got done at his cost departmentally after notice given to him.

The outlet boxes, IC BOXES for Switches and end of conduits etc. of different types of electrical wiring as mentioned in clauses above shall be painted inside/outside with different colours each signifying the different categories mentioned so as to avoid mixing of various circuits and their wiring and nothing extra will be paid for this.

At the time of laying conduit pipe in the slab in recess, the contractor should keep fish wire of 16 SWG GI wire throughout conduit pipe and will have to take special care so that the conduit do not cross through AC ducts, grills, etc.

The contractor should recess the conduits in the walls before they are plastered and in coordination with progress of building works. The conduit should be mechanically and electrically continues.

All the Switch board, SDB and DB shall be clearly sign written indicating the number / type of load / Circuit Nos. etc.

Under ground cables of both 1.1 KV and 11 KV should be subject to pressure/insulation tests before and after laying the same.

While making end connections of wore, no strand shall be cut and termination of wire shall be done with necessary lugs without any extra cost.

The termination of conduits etc. in the junction box should be done by making proper holes instead of cutting the box.

Rs.1/- per empty box for the ceiling fans, fittings and other items supplied by the Department will be recovered from Contractor irrespective of the size of box.

The Contractor will have to make arrangements to take the materials to site of work at his own risk and cost.

If any conduits are laid before the award of work, the same shall be recovered at rate mentioned in SR-94 (Internal) enhanced by abatement of similar items in the tender.

ALL MATERIALS SHALL BE "ISI" MARKED OR APPROVED BY THE BSNL.

General TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. The work is to be carried out as per CPWD specifications (Internal/External) and I.E. Rule amended from time to time & Indian Electricity Rules as amended up to date.
- 2. Good workmanship is an essential requirement to be complied with. The entire work of Manufacture, Fabrication, assembly and installation shall conform to sound engineering practice. Rates quoted shall be inclusive of packing, forwarding, insurance, freight and delivery at site Watched ward of all materials.
- 3. All sundry fittings, assemblies, accessories, hardware items, foundation bolts, termination lugs for electrical connection as required and all other sundry items which are useful & necessary for proper assembly and efficient working of the various components of the works shall be deemed to have been included in the tender.
- 4. Following works shall be carried out by the contractor and therefore their cost shall be deemed to be included in their tendered cost.
 - a) The contractor shall be responsible for repairing all damages and restoring the same to their original finish. He shall also remove at his cost all unwanted and waste materials arising out of his work from his site.
 - b) All chases required in connection with the electrical works shall be provided and filled by the Contractor to the original finish.
 - c) Temporary shed if required over the storage space and locking arrangement, watch and ward of the materials shall be provided by firm till completion of the work and final taking over of the installation by the department.
- 5. The contractor shall employ qualified engineer / supervisor as required and intimate names of Such Persons to the Engineer-in-charge on commencement of work. Failure to employ will attract penalty as per agreement.
- 6. Termination of all connections on main board, sub main board & distribution boards will be done by Crimping method & nothing extra will be paid on this account.
- 7. Numbering and sign writing of the entire installation shall be carried out by the contractor as per Instructions of the Engineer-in-charge for which nothing extra shall be paid.
 - a) On completion of installation following tests shall be carried out.
 - b) Polarity test
 - c) Earth continuity test
- 8. On completion of installation a certificate shall be furnished by the contractor in prescribed Performa, this certificate shall be in addition to the certificate required by local electric Supply Company.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1.0 General

1.1 Except for the items, for which Particular Specifications are given or where it is specifically mentioned otherwise in the description of the items in the schedule of quantities, the work shall generally be carried out in accordance with the "CPWD Specifications 2019 Vol. I &II" with upto date correction slips and as per instructions of Engineer-in-Charge. Wherever CPWD Specifications are silent, the latest IS Codes / Specifications shall be followed and the rates should be all inclusive.

In the case of discrepancy between the Schedule of Quantities, the Specifications and/ or the Drawings, the following order of preference shall be observed:-

- a. Nomenclature of item as per Schedule of Quantities
- b. Special Conditions.
- c. Particular Specifications.
- d. Drawings and specification mentioned in the tender document.
- e. CPWD Specifications-2019 (Vol.-1 & 11) with upto date correction slips.
- f. Indian Standard Specifications
- g. Manufactures Specifications.
- h. Sound Engineering Practice as per the decision of Engineer-in-Charge.
- 1.2 Any reference made to any Indian Standard Specifications, shall imply to the latest version of that standard, including such revisions / amendments as issued by the Bureau of Indian Standards upto last date of receipt of tenders.
- 1.3 The work shall be executed & measured as per metric dimensions given in the Schedule of Quantities, drawings etc. (FPS units wherever indicated are for guidelines only).
- 1.4 work should be planned in a systematic manner so that chase cuttings in the walls, ceilings and floors is minimized. Wherever absolutely essential, the chase shall be cut using chase cutting machines. Chases will not be allowed to be cut using hammer / chisel. The electrical boxes should be fixed in walls simultaneously while raising the brick work. The contractor shall ensure proper co-ordination of various disciplines viz. sanitary & water supply, horticulture & electrical etc.
- 1.5 The hidden items such as conduits, etc. are to be properly tested before covering.
- 1.6 Samples including brand / quality of materials and fittings to be used in the work shall be got approved from the Engineer-in-Charge, well in advance of actual execution and shall be preserved till the completion of the work.
- 1.7 The contractor, his agents / representative, workman etc. shall strictly observe orders pertaining to fire precautions prevailing in the area.
- 1.8 Contractor(s) shall study the details of site, nature of work to be executed, site constraints etc and satisfy himself about complete characteristics and other parameters at site. However, no claim on the alleged inadequacy or incorrectness of the data supplied by the department shall be entertained.
- 1.9 Contractor shall take all precautionary measures to avoid any damage to adjoining property. All necessary arrangement shall be made at his own cost.
- 1.10 The contractor shall take instructions from the Engineer-in-Charge regarding collection and stacking of materials at any place. No excavated earth or building rubbish shall be stacked on areas where other buildings, roads, compound wall, services etc are to be constructed.

- 1.11 The contractor shall provide at his own cost suitable measuring arrangements/instruments as may be necessary at site for checking. All such equipments shall be got calibrated in advance from laboratory, approved by the Engineer-in-Charge. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account.
- 1.12 All fittings and accessories should conform to byelaws and municipal body / corporation / Electricity board, where CPWD Specifications are not applicable. The contractor should get the materials (fixtures/fittings) tested by the Municipal Body / Corporation authorities/Electricity board authorities wherever required at his own cost.
- 1.13 Existing drains, pipes, cables, over-head wires, sewer lines, water lines and similar services encountered in the course of the execution of work shall be protected against the damage by the contractor at his own expense. The contractor shall not store materials or otherwise occupy any part of the site in a manner likely to hinder the operation of such services. In case temporary supporting/shifting of such services is required to facilitate the work, the same shall be done by the contractor at no extra cost.
- 1.14 In case the existing services are to be shifted permanently, then before dismantling the existing services, alternate/diversion of service lines has to be laid by the contractor so that there is no interruption in use of existing services. The contractor has to plan the alternate suitable route for diversion/shifting of service lines and get the same approved from the Engineer-in-Charge before starting shifting of services. Nothing extra shall be paid except the payment of dismantling and laying of new service lines as per conditions of contract.
- 1.15 With each Running Bill, the details of test carried out shall be submitted by the contractor as per prescribed proforma.
- 1.16 On completion of work, the contractor shall submit at his own cost four prints of "as built" drawings to the Engineer-in-Charge. These drawings shall have the following information.
 - (a) Electrical wiring layout diagram with position of switches, fittings, cabling etc.
 - (b) Run off of all water supply lines with diameters, location of control valves, access panels etc. wherever applicable
- 1.17 In case the contractor fails to supply "as built drawing" aforesaid within 30 days of the date of completion, then the recovery @ Rs.10,000/- each for such set of drawings shall be made from the contractor's final bill.
- 2.0 Unless otherwise specified in the schedule of quantities or CPWD specifications, the rates for respective items shall be all inclusive and apply to the following:
 - a) All labour, material, tools & plants & other inputs involved in the execution of item.
 - b) Any of the conditions and specifications mentioned in the tender documents.
 - c) Pumping / bailing out surface water / rain water / sub soil water, if necessary for any reason.
 - d) Any legal or financial implications resulting out of disposal of waste, if any.
 - e) Performance test of the entire installation(s) before the work is finally accepted.
 - f) All incidental charges for cartage, storage 7 safe custody of materials brought to site.

3.0 SECRECY

3.1 The contractor shall take all steps necessary that all persons employed on any work in connection with the contract have notice that the Indian Official Secrets Act 1923 applies to them & will continue so to apply even after the execution of such works under the contract.

- 3.2 The contract is confidential and must be strictly confirmed to the contractor's own use (except so far as confidential disclosure to sub-contractors or suppliers as necessary) and to the purpose of the contract.
- 3.3 All documents, copies thereof & extracts there from furnished to the contractor shall be returned to the Engineer-in-Charge on the completion of the work / works or the earlier determination of the contract.

4.0 LABOUR AND SECURITY

- **4.1** Contractor should provide his plan for deployment of labour and get it approved from the Engineer-in-Charge.
- 4.2 Contractor has to follow the security requirement of the campus and obtain necessary entry passes for the labour and vehicles and follow security checks at entry / exit gates, restriction on movement of vehicle, restricted timings of working etc. The Department however shall assist the contractor in obtaining such passes for movement of vehicles and labour. No claim whatsoever shall be entertained on account of delay in entry of vehicles and labour including restrictions in working hours, if there is any.
- 4.3 The contractor shall employ only Indian Nationals after verifying their antecedents and loyalty. The contractor shall, on demand submit list of his agents, employees and work people concerned & shall satisfy as to the bonafides of such people.
- 4.4 The contractor & his work people shall observe all relevant rules regarding security promulgated in which work is to be carried out by the Controlling Administrative Authority of the campus/area
- 4.5 The contractor, his representative, workman shall be allowed to enter through specified gates & timing as laid down by the controlling authority. They shall be issued an identity card or an individual pass in accordance with the standing rules & regulations & they should possess the same while working. The contractor shall be responsible for the conduct & actions of his workman, agents / representatives.

5.0 TRANSPORTATION AND OFFICE INFRASTRUCTURE:

5.1 In order to complete the work within the scheduled time if the contractor shall be required to do the work in more than one shift and accepted by the department the contractor will provide vehicular facilities to the BSNL site staff to reach the site and their residence at his own cost for their services required beyond the normal office hours. In case the contractor fails to provide the facilities Engineer-in-Charge shall be at liberty to make the arrangement themselves and deduct the respective cost from the contractor's bills.

6.0 PROGRAM CHART: -

- 6.1 The Contractor shall prepare an integrated program chart for the execution of work, showing clearly all activities from the start of work to completion, with details of manpower, equipment and machinery required for the fulfillment of the program within the stipulated period or earlier and submit the same for approval of the Engineer-in-Charge within **15 days** of the issue of letter of acceptance for the contract.
- 6.2 The work has to be completed in stages as indicated in the **Milestones (Wherever provided)** and the program should be prepared in such a manner to achieve these Milestones as indicated therein or earlier.
- 6.3 The program chart should include the following:
 - a) Descriptive note explaining sequence of various activities.
 - b) Network (PERT / CPM / BAR CHART) which will indicate resources in financial terms, manpower and specialized equipment for every important stage.

- c) Program for procurement of materials by the contractor.
- d) Program of procurement of machinery / equipments having adequate capacity, commensurate with the quantum of work to be done within the stipulated period, by the contractor.
- 6.4 If at any time, it appears to the Engineer-in-Charge that the actual progress of work does not conform to the approved program referred above, the contractor shall produce a revised program showing the modifications to the approved program by additional inputs to ensure completion of the work within the stipulated time.
- 6.5 The submission of revised program or approval by the Engineer-in-Charge of such program or the furnishing of such particulars shall not relieve the contractor of any of his duties or responsibilities under the contract. This is without prejudice to the right of Engineer-in-Charge to take action against the contractor as per terms and conditions of the agreement.

Notwithstanding the fact that the contractor will have to pay to the labourers and other staff engaged directly or indirectly on the work according to the provisions of the labour regulations and the agreement entered upon and/or extra amounts for any other reason.

7.0 PROGRESS AND MONITORING OF WORK:

Contractor shall give the Engineer-in-Charge on the 10th day of each month, progress report of the work done during the previous month. Such progress report will include the project progress summary, work progress (planned v/s. actual), PERT chart, milestone status, financial progress status, manpower deployment status, important materials consumed, materials at site at the beginning of the month, materials consumed during the month and the balance quantities at the end of month and progress of the work stating the reasons for shortfall, if any including the steps and measures to be taken for making good the shortfall in the succeeding period. Non submission of aforesaid progress report shall make contractor liable for action under breach of contract conditions. In case of delay in submission of progress report, recovery will be done Rs. 5000/- per week from the Running Account bill, where the decision of EE(E) as to do recovery is final.

8.0 SAMPLE OF MATERIALS:-

- 8.1 All materials and fittings brought by the contractor to the site for use shall conform to the samples approved by the Engineer-in-Charge which shall be preserved till the completion of the work. If a particular brand of material is specified in the item of work in Schedule of Quantity, the same shall be used after getting the same approved from Engineer-in-Charge. Wherever brand / quality of material is not specified in the item of work, the contractor shall submit the samples as per List of Preferred Makes for approval of Engineer-in-Charge. For all other items, ISI Marked materials and fittings shall be used with the approval of Engineer-in-Charge. Wherever 1S1 Marked material / fittings are not available, the contractor shall submit samples of materials / fittings manufactured by firms of repute conforming to relevant Specifications or IS codes for the approval of Engineer-in-Charge.
- 8.2 To avoid delay, contractor should submit samples as stated above well in advance so as to give timely orders for procurement. If any material, even though approved by Engineer-in-Charge is found defective or not conforming to specifications shall be replaced / removed by the contractor at his own risk & cost.

- 8.3. **BIS** marked materials except otherwise specified shall also be subjected to quality test besides testing of other materials as per the specifications described for the item/material. Wherever BIS marked materials are brought to the site of work, the contractor shall, furnish manufacturer's test certificate or test certificate from approved testing laboratory to establish that the material procured by the contractor for incorporation in the work satisfies the provisions of specifications relevant to the material and / or the work done.
- 8.4 For certain items, if tests are neither mentioned in the CPWD Specifications & BIS, then tests shall be carried out as per decision of Engineer-in-Charge.

9. Coordination at site:

At the site of work, as more than one agency may be working, full cooperation shall be extended to other agencies during progress of work. Further, work shall be carried in such a way so that it may not cause abnormal noise and hindrance to the officers of the department engaged in erection as well as doing normal routine work.

10. Joint Inspection;

Since the work is to be executed for the third party, A joint inspection report will be made by the BSNL representative and representative of the firm & representative of client/user regarding the functioning of the system, defects and remedial action required in time schedule for the rectification/remedial action. Agency is bound to attend to the defects/discrepancies in timely manner, failing which Engineer in charge is fully empowered to set right the defects with reasonable notice.

GENERAL SPECIFICATION

1.0 SCOPE OF WORK

- 1.1 Attending of faults in the electromechanical services in Technical installations of BSNL, as applicable in this contract means that all Services included in the schedule of work are kept in healthy, clean and working condition. Specific details of activities required with regard to each service are detailed under sections pertaining to those service/technical specifications.
- 1.2 Attending of faults in the electromechanical services shall be carried out as per instructions contained herein. However all other forms & instructions to be used shall be as per works instructions / forms & checklists etc., issued from time to time.
- 1.3 The Agency has to make own arrangement to obtain key from concern SDE BSS incharge for attending faults and return back the key to the same place. No extra payment will be made.

2.0 **METHODOLOGY**

- 2.1 It is presumed that contractor will provide qualified staff at the site, which will be adequate to perform Attending faults in Window type /Split Type(or) any other type of AC units and all Electro mechanical services,.
- 2.2 In case of faults beyond the capacity of the staff provided as above, contractor shall immediately provide extra-specialized work force so as to attend to the fault in minimum reasonable time without any extra cost.
- 2.3 If during the period of contract, any of the inventory are added/ altered, all inclusive of the same shall be done by the firm.

3.0 MATERIALS AND TOOLS & PLANTS

- 3.1 While attending the faults the replacement of material shall be with the same rating and make as that of the original. The firm may also replace an item with energy efficient item wherever the same is available with the approval of Engineer in charge. However, in case of non-availability of a particular make, Engineer-in-charge will approve the alternate make.
- 3.2 Dismantled and unserviceable items for which a replacement is supplied, shall be removed from the site under intimation to the JTO(E)/SDE(E).
- 3.3 All materials shall be of approved make, model and capacity and shall be matching to the system.
- 3.4. All tools and plants, testing & safety equipments required for carrying out various tasks relevant to fault attending have to be arranged by firm at its own cost.
- 3.5 The firm shall possess sufficient quantity of tools such as screw driver, tester, cutting pliers, tools and meters such as clamp meter, earth megger, insulation tester ,digital thermometer, anemometer etc., of sufficient quantity for carrying out the attending the faults activity.
- The firm shall also coordinate with the JTO (E) / SDE (E) for carrying out energy audit/capacity test at site with respect to AC units.
- 3.7 The Firm/Contractor will provide the workers with necessary Safety Equipments.

4.0 **COMMERCIAL**

- 4.1 The tenderer must obtain himself on his own expenses, all the information necessary for the purpose of tendering, inspect the site and acquaint himself with all the local conditions, means of access to work and nature of work etc. No claim shall be entertained on this account.
- 4.2 The workers engaged by firm should maintain proper discipline and good behavior with occupants.
- 4.3 The firm shall remove such workers from the site whose behaviour is found improper. Executive Engineer's decision in this matter shall be final.
- 4.4 Any damage to the installation (s) / building during the attending the faults period due to the carelessness on the part of maintenance staff shall be the responsibility of firm & be replaced / rectified without any extra cost.
- 4.5 Any accident or damage during attending the faults will be the responsibility of agency & BSNL will not entertain any claim, compensation, penalty etc. on this account or on account of non-observance of law to the work.
- 4.6 Agency has to observe all the labour rules & regulations in force.
- 4.7 Dismantled materials shall be returned to the department except those items for which the replacement is supplied by the agency.
- 4.8 The BSNL reserves the right to carry out any work at the risk and cost of the agency, if the agency fails to perform any duty as per the contract.
- 4.9 The tenderer must obtain himself at his own expense all the information necessary for the purpose of execution, before tendering.
- 4.10 The agency should inspect the site & acquaint itself with all the local condition, means of access to work & nature of work etc. No claim shall be entertained on these accounts.
- 4.11 The contractor shall not sublet the work or part thereof. However, services of specialised agencies for specified work can be obtained.
- 4.12 The firm shall maintain the installation(s) in such a way as to provide uninterrupted required conditions in air conditioned rooms.
- 4.13 The BSNL reserves the right to terminate the contract by giving show-cause notice of One Month duration at any time during the currency of the contract.
- 4.14 The BSNL reserves the right to extend the contract as per the provisions of agreement at the same rate & conditions.
- 4.15 The contractor has to keep all the Electro mechanical equipment at site neat and clean to avoid any accident and fire hazard.
- 4.16 Firm should have the round the clock contact number. In case of emergency contractor and authorized engineer / supervisor shall be available at the site on short notice from engineer-in-charge and make efforts to take situation to normal at the earliest.
- 4.17 The contractor agrees that he shall at all times indemnify BSNL against all claims for compensation under the provisions of any law for the time being in force or in respect of any person employed by it in carrying out the contract. Further, such staff has no right to claim employment in BSNL.
- 4.18 Contractor has to observe all the labour rules and regulations in force & BSNL shall not be liable for any default.
- 4.19 The Firm/Contractor will provide the workers with necessary Testing and Safety Equipment.
- 4.20 BSNL is having right to pre close the agreement in special cases with One Month notice without assigning any reason.
- 4.21 BSNL is having the right to curtail the quantity according to the requirement.

4.22 The rates quoted must be full & final. Nothing extra is payable other than quoted rates. Clause10-CC shall not be applicable for this account.

5.0 **DAMAGES TO BSNL INSTALLATION**:

- 5.1 Any damage to the installation(s)/building While attending the faults due to the carelessness on the part of maintenance staff shall be the responsibility of firm/contractor & shall be replaced/rectified by the firm without any extra cost.
- 5.2 Any accident or damage during attending the fault period will be the responsibility of the firm/contractor & BSNL will not entertain any claim, compensation, penalty etc. on this account or on account of non observance of any other requirement of law relevant to his work.

6.0 CURRENCY OF CONTRACT:

- 6.1 The currency of contract shall be **4_months**. BSNL reserves the right to terminate the contract by giving show cause notice of one-month duration at any time during the currency of the contract.
- a. The BSNL reserves the right to curtail any quantity during the currency of contract without assigning any reason.
- 6.2 The BSNL reserves the right to extend the contract for a maximum period of One Month (One Month at a time) at the same rates & conditions, without the consent of the firm and beyond this period with mutual consent.

7.0 **TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:**

- 7.1 Right is reserved by BSNL for terminating the contract due to serious default. This includes major break down or accident or loss due to negligence on the part of firm, failure to attend breakdown, disobedience and abandoning the site etc. In such a case, Full Performance Guarantee shall be forfeited to BSNL. The decision of Executive Engineer (E) in this regard shall be final and binding.
- 7.2 Right is reserved by BSNL for closure of the contract at any time by giving One Month's notice without assigning any reasons. The decision of Executive Engineer shall be final and binding on the contractor for closure of contract and for which BSNL shall not entertain any claim.

8. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 8.1 The contractor shall not sublet the work. However, services of specialized agencies for specific work can be obtained.
- 8.2 The contractor agrees that he shall at all times indemnify BSNL against all claims for compensation under the provisions of any law for the time being in force or in respect of any person employed by it in carrying out the contract. Further, such staff has no right to claim employment in BSNL.
- 8.3 The Contractor will provide the workers with necessary T & P, Testing & safety equipments.
- 8.4 Contractor has to observe all the labour rules and regulations in force & BSNL shall not be liable for any default.
- 8.5 Firm is responsible to keep workable spares and consumables for due
- 8.6 As service such as Air-conditioning services are of critical nature, the firm will ensure that the labours engaged are well trained to take responsibility and initial steps under emergency situation.

8.7 In case of Emergency, contractor and/or his authorized engineer or supervisor shall be available at short notice from Engineer-in-charge and make all efforts to make the situation normal at the earliest.

9. TEST CHECK BY THE FIELD ENGINEERS:

For the purpose of assessing the quality of service rendered by the firm against the above contract, the SDE & JTO shall carryout inspection & test checks of the service/work under the contract periodically.

10.0 **Guarantee and Defect Liability**

- The guarantee for replaced components / equipments/spares shall be valid for twelve months from date of replacements. The contractor shall guarantee that all replaced components / equipments/spares are free from any defects and also the equipments work with satisfactory performance and efficiency not less than the guaranteed values.
- 10.2 In case the contractor fails to depute his representative to attend the fault within the time frame stipulated in various clauses or fails to cause remedial measure within reasonable time, BSNL may proceed to do so at the contractor's risk and expenses and without prejudice to any right of the BSNL to recover such expenses.
- 10.3 Wherever AC units/ components of other services are replaced by BSNL, the firm shall take over such units/services immediately on expiry of guarantee period.
