



Special FRC for the citizens of Nepal and Bhutan taking new SIM connection in India under GSM Prepaid Mobile Services.

It is hereby conveyed that a Special FRC-559 (only for Citizens of Nepal and Bhutan visiting India) under GSM Prepaid Mobile Services in CHTD (including TN Circle) is available w.e.f 17.01.2025:

Introduction of New FRC-559 for the citizens of Nepal and Bhutan taking new SIM connection in India:

Conditions:

- I. FRC559 is special FRC for the citizens of the Nepal and Bhutan only.
- II. Migration to other plans not allowed and also all IR voucher IRSTV57/IR STV167 or any other IR STV will not be applicable for these FRCs. No STV recharge allowed under this FRC559. No International roaming shall be permitted on such mobile connections.
- III. The connection under FRC559 shall be disconnected/deactivated /deleted, from the date of activation, i.e. validity of visa/maximum time permitted for them to stay in India/90 days whichever is earlier.
- IV. Dual IMSI SIM shall not be applicable for special FRC559 for the citizens of Nepal and Bhutan taking new connections in India.

When the Citizen of Nepal/Bhutan coming from their respective origin countries, with Nepalese/ Bhutanese citizenship document, Voter Identification Card issued by EC of Nepal/Bhutan or Limited validity photo identity issued by Nepalese/Royal Bhutanese Mission then these documents may be treated as valid proof of identity documents as an alternative to passport.

In case of Citizens of Nepal or Bhutan entering into India from a place other than their respective origin countries, then they have to provide copy of passport along with valid visa stamp and the Visa limit is 90days or more.

- The above tariff will be implemented w.e.f 17.01.2025.
